You can branch out from your main topic, adding ideas and further branches as you go on. Each branch will be placed in an optimal spatial position. You can also start various branches on different topics or parts of it and join to create loops and process flows.

Text2mindmap

This is a free online tool that works the same way as bullet points. Using the tool is simple and fast: You enter the text to create a map and use indented text to branch out of the main topic. The change in the arrangement will be reflected live on the map while allowing you to drag the nodes to arrange the space as you like.

FreeMind

An opensource tool that gets the best out of a fusion of mind mapping and bulleting. A simple user interface that gets the job done through a few clicks and adding a 'child' and 'parent' nodes. Another attractive feature of this tool is its folding and unfolding feature that allows one to declutter the space when working on specific parts of the map. It also allows for different essay mind maps to be managed in the same space with its feature of essay status telling you which essay is active, incomplete, or not started.

MindMap

It is one of many Google Chrome extensions that can be used to perform your essay brainstorming. It is simple to use and allows the user to include media in the maps, which makes it appealing. It has also the option to be stored and retrieved from Cloud, Dropbox, and Google Drive.

Mind42

Mind42 is an online mind mapping tool that can be used for brainstorming from your internet browser.
